How to Submit a Proposal

The session proposal form serves to document the speaker's vision of the proposed session and how he/she intends to treat the various issues generated in the topic. The FSP Executive will make speaker selections after a comprehensive review of the session proposal documentation and bona fides.

FSP is looking for sessions at a Strategic, Tactical or Operational level on the following topics:

- AI in Cyber Security / Defense
- Cloud Forensics
- Threat Hunting and Current Data Breaches
- IoT Threats
- Big Data Management

SESSION PROPOSALS must include:

- Name
- Company
- Email address
- Session Title
- 3 key Learning Objectives
- Session outline (150-200 words)

How Speakers Are Chosen

The proposals are evaluated in whole or in part on the following criteria:

- Subject matter relevance and timeliness
- Clearly stated learning objectives and purpose
- Practical application of material
- Context of the issues including real-world case studies, examples, and stories
- Speaker presentation skills and experience
- Education focus devoid of overt and covert commercialism
- Overall quality of the written proposal
- Avoidance of sales or marketing focus
